
According to the Ministry of Industry and Trade, only 24% of public buildings met the energy performance requirements.








Components of institutional financing in 2014 - 2020 (billion CZK)





Use max 1 – 3 areas


> select only some tables and only some numbers

Use markers


→ e.g. for numbers, arrows, pictures









